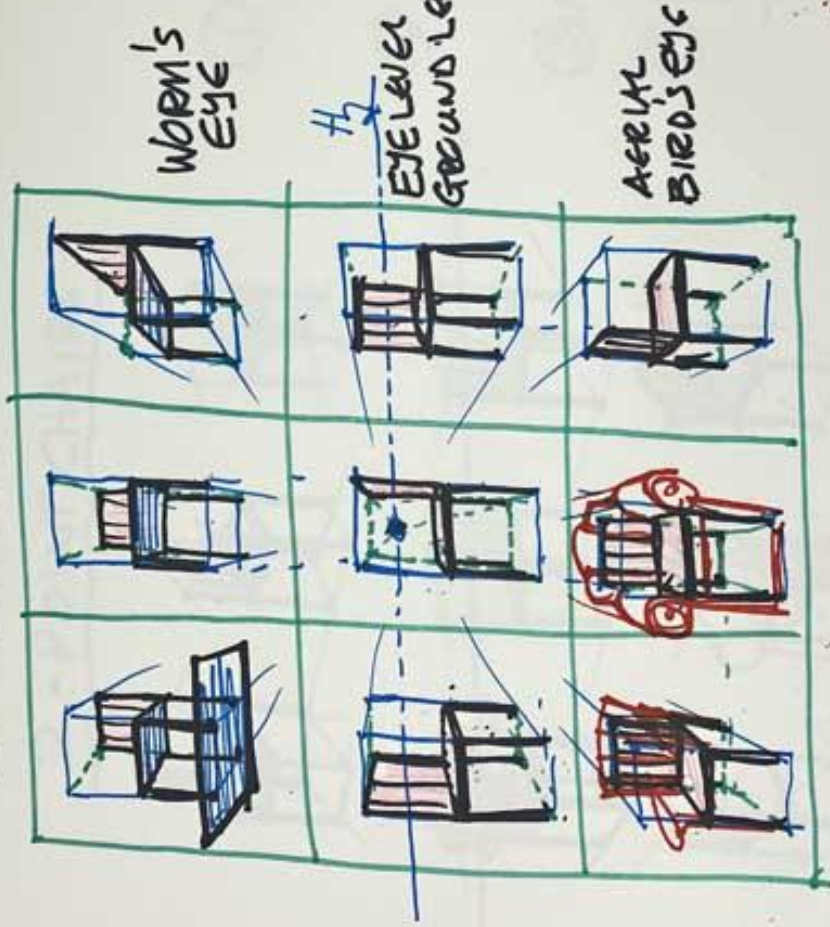

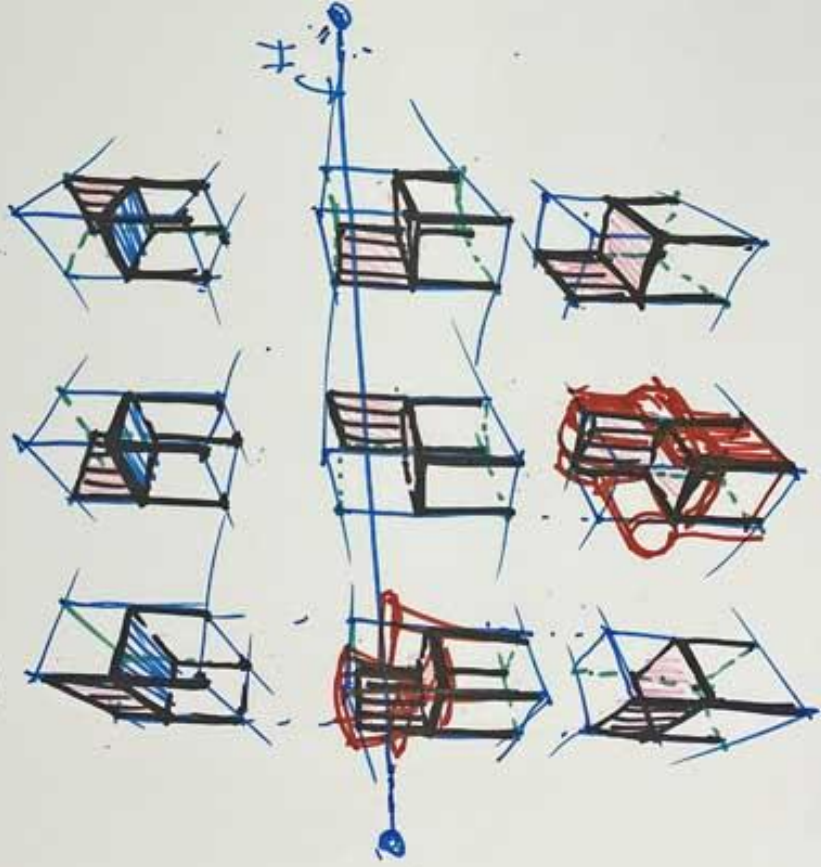

1-POINT CHAIRS



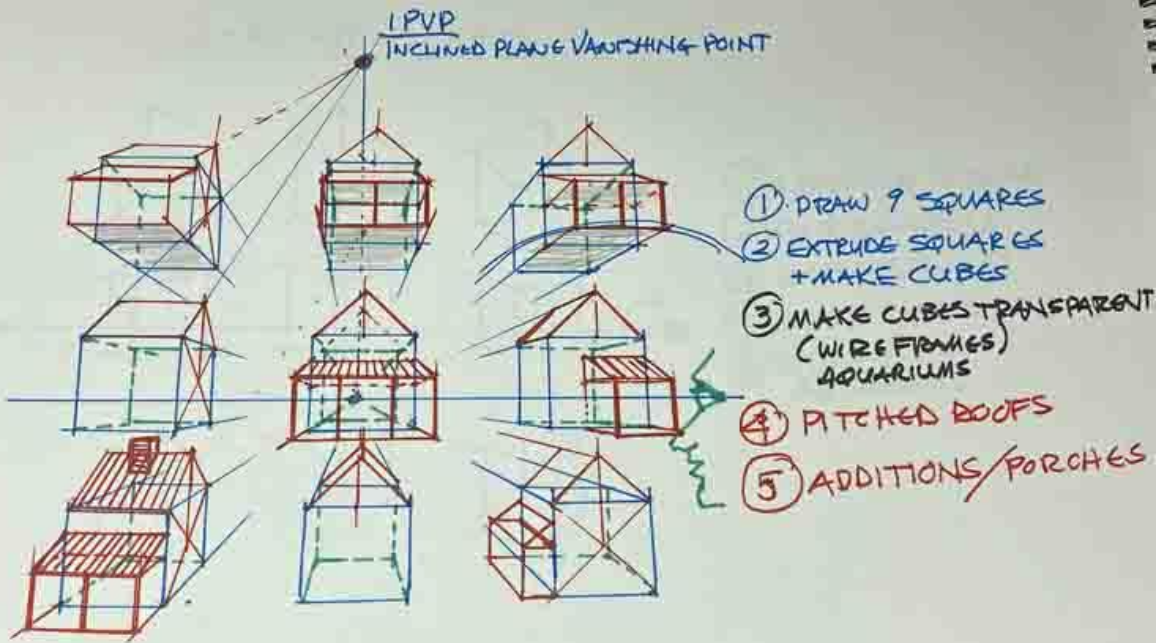
- ① DRAW 9 BOXES
(BEGIN WITH RECTANGLES)
- ② MAKE BOXES TRANSPARENT
'WIRE-FRAMES'
- LIKE AQUARIUMS
- ③ MAP SIMPLE CHAIRS
INTO THE BOXES
- ④ DRAW MORE INTERESTING
CHAIRS OVER THE SIMPLE ONES
(MAYBE TRACING PAPER?)
CAN BE ALL THE SAME CHAIR
OR VARY THEM.

2-POINT CHAIRS



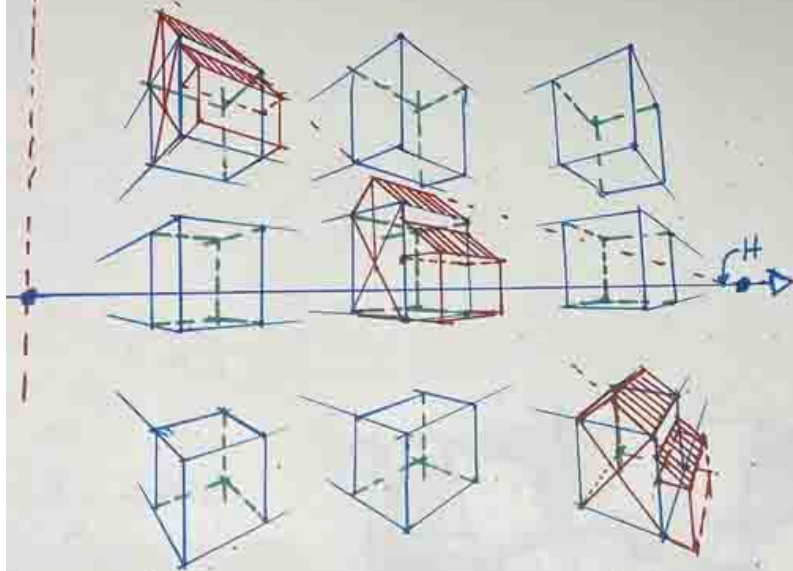
- ① DRAW BOXES
(BEGIN WITH
LEADING CORNERS)
- ② TRANSFER JUST-IZE
THE BOXES - WIRE-FRAMES
(AQUARIUMS)
- ③ MAP CHAIRS INTO BOXES
(SIMPLE CHAIRS)
- ④ DRAW MORE INTERESTING
CHAIRS OVER THE SIMPLE ONES
- ALL THE SAME OR
ALL DIFFERENT
(TRACING PAPER?)

1-POINT THUMBNAILS



INCLINED PLANE V.P.

2-POINT BOXES



- ① LEADING CORNERS
- ② EXTRUDE-WALLS
- ③ EXTENTS/LIMITS
- ④ FINISH BOXES
- ⑤ WIRE-FRAME
AQUARIUMS

⑥ ADD PITCHED ROOFS
+ SHED PORCH.

(HINT-MAKE ROOF PITCHES
FAIRLY HIGH
-MAKE SHEDS NARROW)

2 - POINT THUMBNAILS
